**Undergraduate Course Repeat and Course Forgiveness Policies
Fall 2009 Changes**

Use this handy guide to help advise students on what the new rules mean for them.

Old SDSU Policy	Fall 2009 Policy
Course Repeat	
Students may repeat courses only if they earned grades of "C-" or lower. This is not enforced during registration.	Students may repeat courses only if they earned grades of "C-" or lower. This will be enforced during registration.
No limit to the number of course repeats in instances where grades are averaged.	Students can repeat no more than 28 units.
Course Forgiveness	
Students are not limited based on number of units. Course forgiveness can be applied to 4 lower division courses and 1 upper division course.	Students may use course forgiveness for a maximum of 16 semester units as part of the 28-unit course repeat limit. No more than one course may be an upper division course.
A course may be repeated twice for course forgiveness.	A course may be repeated once for course forgiveness.
	Students may not use course forgiveness for courses for which the original grade was the result of a finding of academic dishonesty.
